

Consortia

ASME works with consortia of various types and sizes and welcomes discussion with all consortium managers.

A consortium should consist of at least five member institutions, with a single point of contact for negotiations. The consortium should sign one license agreement and pay through one invoice.

Each institution within the consortium will need to appoint an account administrator who is responsible for setting up the institution's account and will receive any service communications. COUNTER-compliant usage statistics are provided for each institution. ASME now offers a consortia report based on COUNTER 3-compliant data.
